FOOD CLOSET UPDATE

Our Carmichael Food Closet remains open as an essential function. They have implemented daily sanitizing procedures and have modified the distribution process so that volunteers have NO direct contact with the public to maintain proper social distancing. The Food Closet Ministry is critically important to our community and, like grocery stores, are approved to stay open during this time of shelter-in-place.

The Food Closet served its maximum of 25 families every day this week; they are clearly filling a need.
