FOOD CLOSET UPDATE

Our Carmichael Food Closet remains open as an essential function. They have implemented daily sanitizing procedures and have modified the distribution process so that volunteers have NO direct contact with the public. They are also picking up food from the Sacramento Food Bank and Walmart at Madison & Manzanita several times a week.

Many of the regular volunteers are not able to work their usual shifts as they shelter-in-place.

One of the biggest needs is for volunteers to drive/ride in the church van to <u>pick up food supplies</u>. If you can help pick up food for our Food Closet during the current emergency, please contact Ernie Chard at <u>e.chard@sbcglobal.net</u> or 916-485-8951.
