WELCOME OUR GUEST PREACHER

Rev. Dr. Gary R. Califf, Ch, Col (Ret) USAF and his wife, Kathy have 12 grandchildren (with one more due in June), in addition to their children Ben, Christina, Michelle, and Cassie who all remember fondly their formative CPC years in the 90's. Prior to CPC, Gary was an elementary school teacher and guidance counselor, a Columbia Theological Seminary student, an intern pastor in Metairie, LA, and a solo pastor in Asheville, NC. Commissioned as Air Force Reserve Chaplain in 1984, Shaw AFB SC was his first duty station.

As CPC's Associate Pastor, he served mission, youth, Stephen Ministry, and Deacons while doing monthly duty at McClellan AFB and Beale AFB. Following CPC, he served PC(USA) churches in Cincinnati, OH and DuBois, PA, where he honorably retired from Presbytery of Huntingdon in 2017. As a reserve chaplain, Gary served at the USAF Academy in Colorado Springs and Air Combat Command at Langley AF VA. He also volunteered for deployments at Ellsworth AFB SD, Manta Ecuador counter drug missions, and Enduring Freedom, Ramadi Operating Base Iraq.

After earning his MS in Strategic Studies at Air War College, he accepted full-time Air Force positions first as Deputy, then as USAF Reserve Command Chaplain at Warner Robins AFB GA. He retired in 2017 with 33 years of service and was awarded the Legion of Merit medal.

Gary and Kathy live on Treasure Lake, PA, enjoy summers with grandchildren on their pontoon boat, and snowbird winters in their fifth wheel camper in southern states.
