All are welcome to Ash Wednesday worship in the Sanctuary on March 5 at 7:00 p.m. This contemplative service begins the Lenten season with the imposition of ashes and the Lord's Supper. COMMUNION CHANGES COMING SOON

The Worship Division will be implementing changes to how we serve in-person Communion in order to better adhere to recommendations in CPC's Earth Care Congregation recertification. We are seeking to reduce waste and to make the Lord's Supper accessible to everyone. To this end, beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 5, Communion will include only gluten-free bread and will be served by intinction (dipping the bread into a common cup). This will enable us to serve intinction style without fear of contaminating the juice with wheat and will feel more inclusive for all. The bread will be spread out on trays without individual paper cups, and a common cup will be used.
