WINTER RESPITE

FEBRUARY 17 AND FEBRUARY 24

Since January 6, Carmichael Presbyterian Church (CPC) in cooperation with Carmichael HART (Homeless Assistance Resource Team) has provided Winter Respite on Mondays (in addition to Saturday shower ministry), for our homeless neighbors in McMillen Hall. Other churches who are part of Carmichael HART have provided breakfast and showers and a safe and warm place for people to be. On Wednesdays the same thing happens at Crossroads Church.

February 17 and 24 are CPC's turn to host Winter Respite. Monday, February 17 is President's Day, and I hope some of you who work or go to school during the day might be able to help. Students under the age of 15 are welcome with parent supervision. Those over 15 can volunteer on their own. (It's a great way to get community service hours!)

There are two shifts each day. 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Volunteers help prepare and serve breakfast, supervise the showers, welcome our guests, and help clean up.
