SCRIPTURE READING Luke 11:1-13

He was praying in a certain place, and after he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." ²So he said to them, "When you pray, say:

Father, may your name be revered as holy.

May your kingdom come.


