People: The needs of the world are so great; O Lord, increase our faith.


Leader: The law is slack, and justice does not prevail.





Pastor: People will come from east and west and north and south to sit at table in the

Kingdom of God.

They will come with hope and they will come with doubts. They will come with faith and they will come with fears. They will come with love and they will come with regrets.

They will come from all over. They will come across all sorts of barriers and boundaries. They will come. They will all come for God longs for it to be so.

COMMUNION OF THE PEOPLE

If you are worshiping via live stream, place a plate with bread or crackers and a cup with juice, wine, water, or other common beverage in your home worship space. Wherever you are, you are invited to partake of the bread and the cup.

If you are worshiping in person, please come down the center aisle to receive the communion elements.

You can choose intinction (dipping the bread into the cup) from the servers nearest the center aisle or bread and individual cups from the servers nearest the outside aisles.

Gluten-free bread will be available from the servers nearest the outside aisles. Ushers will bring communion to the seats of those who cannot come forward.


