FOOD CLOSET NEEDS

You have been hearing on the news that SNAP recipients (also known as CalFresh or food stamps) are not receiving benefits in November due to the shutdown of the federal government. This impacts roughly 270,000 people in Sacramento County, and we are already seeing a surge in demand at the Carmichael Food Closet. Here's how you can help meet the need:

- **Volunteer** – We have expanded volunteer opportunities as this need increases. We need AM volunteers to sort food and stock shelves, and PM volunteers on Mondays, Tuesdays, and twice on Thursdays to distribute. Get detailed information and sign up at <https://signup.com/go/aZUPgfc>. If volunteer slots are full email carmfc5645@gmail.com as extra volunteers are needed to help monitor the car line and hand out information.
- **Food** – In demand right now are cereal/oatmeal, canned protein/tuna, canned soups, peanut butter, jam/jelly, and fresh produce. Food donations can be brought to worship on Sundays or to the church office Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- **Money** – Financial donations allow us to purchase fresh items like milk and eggs at discounted prices, and bulk food orders from Sacramento Food Bank and Family Services. Give online at <https://carmichaelpresbyterian.breezechms.com/give/online> (the top dropdown menu gives the choice of "Give to Food Closet") or mail a check to CPC with "Food Closet" in the memo line.
