Leader: The angel told Joseph, "You are to name the baby Jesus, for he will save his


people from their sins." Believe the good news of the gospel. (Matthew 1:21)



SCRIPTURE READING Matthew 11:2-11

<sup>2</sup> When John heard in prison what the Messiah was doing, he sent word by his disciples <sup>3</sup> and said to him, "Are you the one who is to come, or are we to wait for another?" <sup>4</sup> Jesus answered them, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: <sup>5</sup> the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, those with a skin disease are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them. <sup>6</sup> And blessed is anyone who takes no offense at me."

That prevent us from forgiving


That constrict our hearts from loving
