Singing these songs also expresses enslaved people's hope for a better world in their heavenly home, and on earth as well. Spirituals were sung during civil rights protests, some with altered lyrics. This song continues that tradition with a call for "freedom in our land."

Offertory: "There Is a Balm in Gilead," was one of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s favorite songs. Coretta Scott King said that he often quoted it when he was feeling low. Dr. King's other beloved songs included "Precious Lord, Take My Hand," "If I Can Help Somebody," and "We Shall Overcome."
