Music Notes

One of today's hymns, "Come Sing, O Church, in Joy!" uses a familiar hymn tune from 1770. The text was the winner of a hymn competition sponsored by the Presbyterian Church (USA) Bicentennial committee in 1989. Its theme was "celebrate the journey." This text was written by Brian Dill, a Presbyterian pastor. The second of today's hymns, "Great God of Every Blessing," employs a familiar tune penned by Samuel Wesley in 1864. Most often sung with the words "The Church's One Foundation," today's text was written by David Gambrell in 2009, the 500th anniversary of John Calvin's birth.

Today's Communion music, "How Beautiful," is one Twila Paris's more well-known songs. It debuted on her ninth album of contemporary Christian music in 1991.
