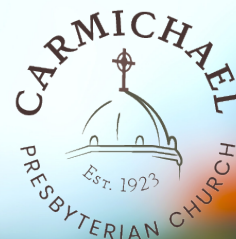

Summer Sunday Seminar

Jerusalem has long been called “the navel of the world,” and this ancient city, now the disputed modern capital of Israel, contains in and around its walls the remains of the Jewish Second Temple; the Islamic shrine called the Dome of the Rock as well as the Al-Aqsa Mosque, and nearby, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Mount of Olives, and Garden of Gethsemane.

Join Music Director Keith Atwater, retired Professor of Humanities and Religious Studies at American River College, for “Jerusalem, Holy City to Three Faiths: Judaism, Christianity, and Islam” on Sunday, July 19 at 11:15 a.m. in McMillen Hall. Keith will offer an “armchair tour” of these key places and their deep significance as found in archaeology, sacred texts (the Hebrew Bible, the New Testament, the holy Qur’an) and the faith, hopes, and dreams of millions.
